Verbal description: S. S. RED OAK VICTORY is currently berthed in the San Francisco Bay, at Richmond, California. It is immediately adjacent and south of the Port of Richmond's Terminal One warehouse. The water-bound site lies east of Point Richmond (also known as Ferry Point) and northwest of Point San Pablo. These points are at the southern end of the line of hills known as Potrero San Pablo. The ship's address is 1500 Dornan Drive, which is shown on the USGS map as Garrard Blvd.

Boundary Justification: S. S. RED OAK VICTORY ship is a floating structure bounded by water. Its current location is described above and is indicated on USGS map by an "X".
